Service Location

Woodcroft College Vacation Care operates from the Woodcroft College Junior School Activity Room.

Operating Hours

The Vacation Care Program operates from 6:45 am to 6:15 pm during the school holidays & Pupil Free Days.

Arrival & Departure

Upon arrival and departure parents are to sign their children in and out on the daily attendance sheet. This is a legal requirement. Children cannot sign themselves in and out.

Enrolment

All children attending the Vacation Care Program must be enrolled with Woodcroft College OSHC. Enrolment Forms can be located on the College website, or a hard copy can be collected from the OSHC Junior School Activity room.

Vacation Care Bookings

Bookings are open from Monday 9 December 2019.

Bookings close Wednesday 11 December 2019.

Please return your completed booking forms along with your signed excursion forms, Direct Debit Authority form and Agreement to OSHC staff. Bookings will not be confirmed if your child is not enrolled with Woodcroft College OSHC.

Daily Fee

\$60 per child, per day.

Fee Payment

To attend Vacation Care please fill in a Direct Debit Authority form and return with your enrolment. Invoices will be sent weekly by email.

Child Care Subsidy System (CCSS)

From 2 July 2018, Child Care Subsidy payments are made directly to services on behalf of families. To ensure you do not miss out on your Child Care Subsidy, complete your assessment as soon as you have filled in your registration form. Families can do their assessment through myGov using their Centrelink online account or through the Express plus Centrelink mobile app.

Cancellations

Once we have received your booking form, full fees will be charged for any cancellations, unless we are able to fill your child's spot from our waitlist.

What to Bring

Recess, lunch, afternoon tea and a water bottle must be brought each day.

If children are staying for a long day, we do suggest you pack extra snacks.

We follow the Woodcroft College Nut Free Policy. No food containing nuts is to be brought to Vacation Care.

Sun Smart Policy

A copy of the sun safe policy is available upon request.

Slip: Please pick lightweight loose clothing during vacation care period. Clothing needs to cover most of your child's body including arms and legs. No thongs are to be worn during Vacation Care.

Slop: It is recommended that sunscreen be liberally applied to all areas of skin that is difficult to cover with clothing.

Slap: As from October 2018, it is policy that every child must be wearing a Woodcroft College hat during Vacation Care.
