Established in 1989, Woodcroft College is a modern co-educational independent day school located in Adelaide, South Australia.

With a strong International Program, the school welcomes students from overseas who wish to study in Australia. The school can provide opportunities for full-time study or shorter-term study abroad and study tour programs. This is complemented by our partnership with Adelaide International School (AIS) for our international students to enrol in an appropriate English for Academic Purpose course to help students achieve the level of English skills necessary to be successful in their studies.

The curriculum is broad is designed to challenge students to think progressively and courageously, and to strive for high standards and personal success. We want our students to be well-balanced, successful young people. Our role is to uncover and nurture our students' strengths as we create the space to grow and learn through diverse experiences.

At a senior level, students will study the South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE) as a pathway to university. Extensive subject selection and career counselling are offered to each of our students to ensure they are aware of their options and post-school choices.

As a school founded in the Anglican tradition of kindness and compassion, Woodcroft is recognised for its spirit of generosity, social justice and service. We encourage our students to understand, accept and value each other's differences without judgement.

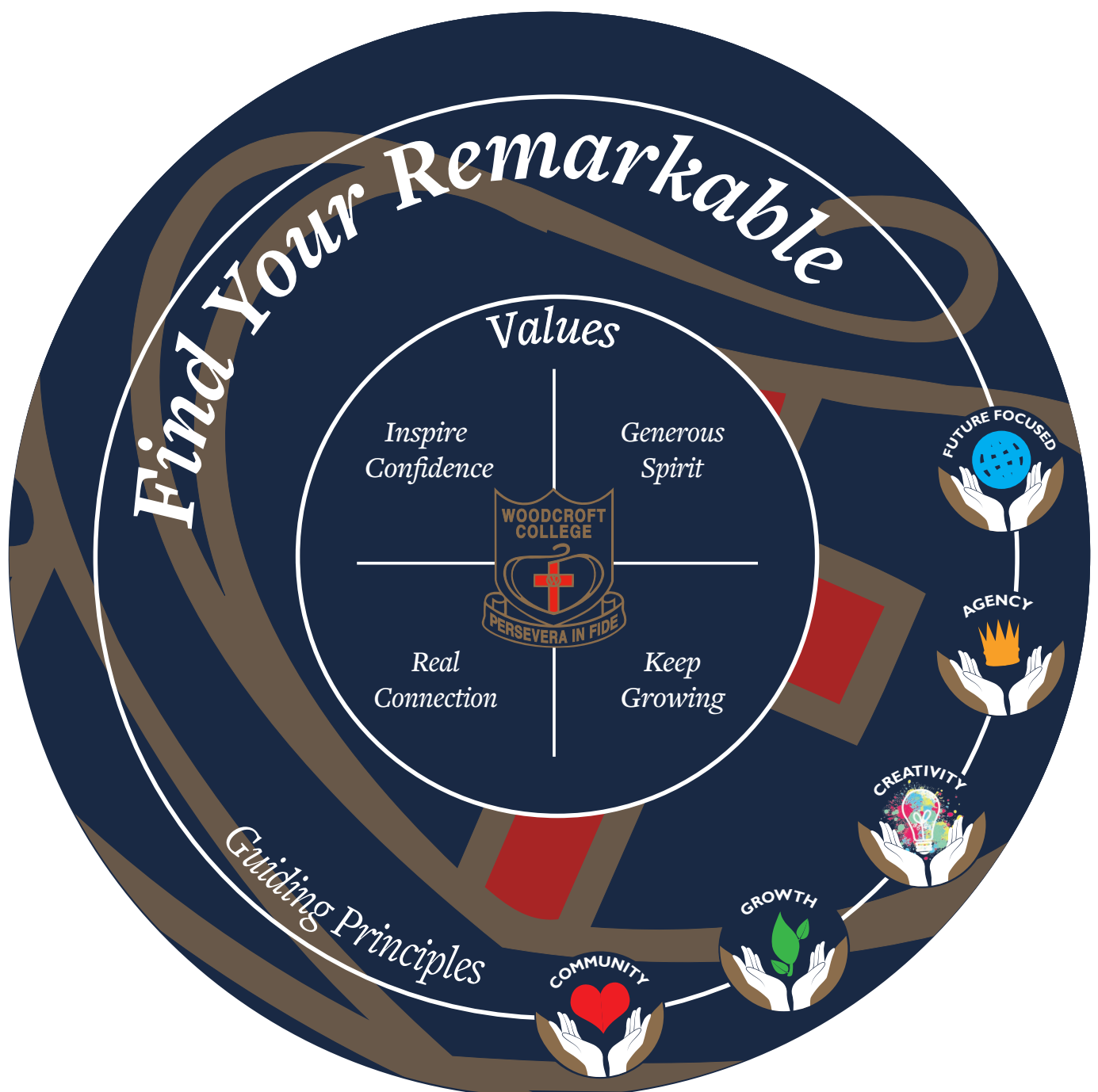
THE LEARNING EXPERIENCE

STUDY OPTIONS

Study Tour. 3 - 4 weeks

An immersion experience for individual students or groups from the same school. Students attend classes, live with local families and experience some of our wonderful environment.



Study Abroad. One Term, One Semester or One Year

Students can choose to study for up to one year. Students will experience the curriculum and extra-curricular activities. This program provides formal assessment and reports for students to continue their schooling in their home country. Living with local families, students will have the opportunity to experience life in Australia and our unique environment.



STUDY OPTIONS

Full Time

Study for two to five years with classes in Senior School of 20 students or less. Students can complete their schooling at Woodcroft College to achieve a South Australian Certificate of Education and university entrance score.



DEVELOPING ENGLISH SKILLS

All classes at Woodcroft College are taught in English and completing high school study at our school will be excellent preparation for university study.

International students choosing full-time enrolment are often required to provide evidence of their English proficiency to determine if they require further preparation for classes at the College.

Woodcroft College is pleased to partner with Adelaide International School (AIS) for our international students to enrol in an appropriate English for Academic Purpose course based on identified needs from their English proficiency test reports. Attending AIS will support students to gain confidence in a safe and non-competitive environment. Specialist teachers teach all courses and students will experience a typical school day program.

Students will join our College community once they meet the English proficiency requirements for the Year level they wish to enter.



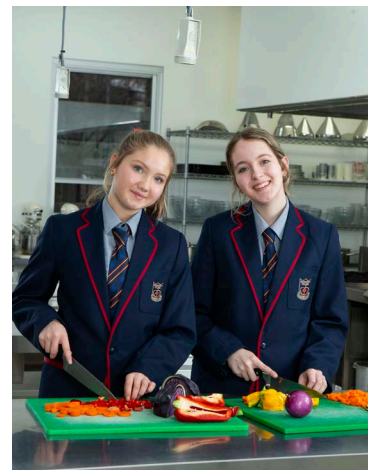
BROAD CURRICULUM

Core academic subjects are supported by many elective subject choices across Middle and Senior School. Students in Year 11 and Year 12 will complete the South Australian Certificate of Education with alternative Vocational Education Training (VET) as pathways to university, further education or employment.

Woodcroft will provide a safe and welcoming home environment . For students, living with a Homestay family gives an opportunity to develop English skills and experience life in an Australian home. Our Homestay families will provide a student with their own room, all meals and help with adjusting to the Australian culture and lifestyle. They will be a home away from home and provide the right level of care and support.

We work with Happy Homestay Adelaide and ensuring a safe home environment is our first priority - all families have appropriate checks and meet compliance standards. Happy Homestay Adelaide will make regular visits and stay in touch with families, students and the school.



WARM WELCOME AND SUPPORT



The College has a strong focus on wellbeing and support throughout a student's time at the school. From first arrival at the airport to orientation sessions at school, to meeting a local 'buddy' student there is plenty of support in the first weeks at the College.

As the student settles into life at Woodcroft College, an English speaking teacher can provide learning and study support in class and after school. The teacher will support the development of good study habits along with helping students make the right subject choices to support their future goals. Our after school study sessions are available for all students who attend Woodcroft.
