

SCHOOL ENTRY ASSESSMENT (SEA)

The School Entry Assessment (SEA) is a nationally recognised early years assessment tool of literacy and numeracy development. The SEA continuum is used by early years educators to collect information about the knowledge, skills and understandings that children bring to school. Educators use this information to track children's learning and development in the early years and to plan programs that meet the needs of each child.

Our teachers administer the test to all Reception children during the first five weeks of starting school.

Children attend full days of school on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday for the first five weeks of Term 1. Each child is allocated a one hour appointment with their teacher on one of the five Wednesdays between 8.30am and 4.30pm at the beginning of first term.
