# EXPERIENCES FOR STUDENTS

Woodcroft College is pleased to provide a range of Faculty trips and cultural tours to students in Middle and Senior School.

Students are provided with opportunities to develop cultural awareness, strengthen knowledge, and build leadership and sportsmanship skills. Students will gain confidence, learn about teamwork and strengthen real connection with peers and staff. And of course, make lifelong memories.

## DRAMA FACULTY

Year 10 to Year 12 Drama students are offered an annual trip to Sydney. This trip provides students with the opportunity to experience theatre productions that are not available in South Australia along with a tour of the Opera House. Students will also participate in workshops at Australia's leading theatre institutes, NIDA and Bell Shakespeare.

Timing	Friday, end of Term 2
Duration	4 days/3 nights
Cost	\$1,750 per student

# LANGUAGE FACULTY

The Language Faculty offers annual Cultural Tours to Japan and Germany to students in Year 10 and 11. Cultural Tours are designed to provide students with an exciting blend of cultural and language immersion, as well as sightseeing.

While the Cultural Tours are non-curriculum, priority will be given to students studying the language.

## Germany

Timing Final week of Term 3 and school holidays  
Duration Up to 3 weeks  
Cost \$7,000 to \$8,000 per student

## Japan

Timing Term 3 school holidays  
Duration Up to 2 weeks  
Cost \$5,000 to \$6,000 per student

Cultural tours are dependent on a minimum number of participating students.

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# MUSIC FACULTY

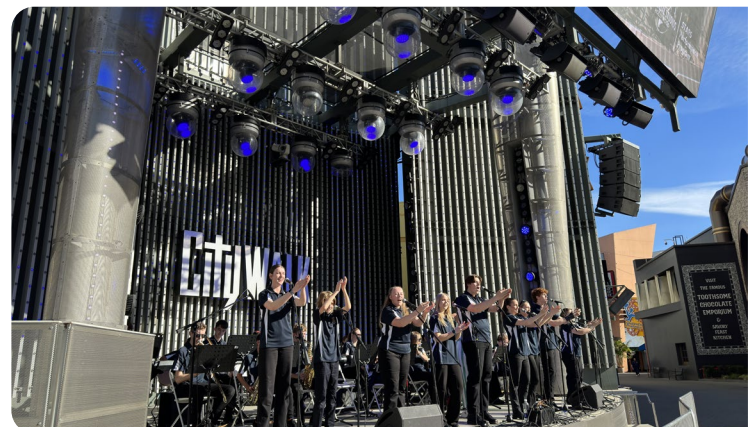
The Music Tour offers students in the Middle and Senior school the opportunity to perform in the USA as part of a band (vocals and instruments). In previous tours students have performed on stages in New York's Lincoln Centre, San Francisco's Union Square, the LA Farmer's Market, LA's Madame Tussauds on Hollywood Boulevard, Disneyland and Universal Studios.

Students will be expected to attend band rehearsals outside of school hours in preparation for the Tour. This is a non-curriculum trip and any student who participates in the extra-curricular music program is able to join the biennial Music Tour to the USA.

Timing	Week 8 or Week 9 in Term 4
Length	Up to 2 weeks
Cost	\$9,000 to \$10,000 per student (dependent on destination and number of students)

This tour is dependent on a minimum number of participating students.

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# OUTDOOR EDUCATION FACULTY

The Outdoor Education Faculty runs the Year 10 Future Leaders program. This involves selected students participating in mandatory trips over the year. The cost of each trip is included in the Future Leaders program fees.

# OUTDOOR EDUCATION FACULTY

Future Leaders are encouraged to participate in the final trip of the school year. Year 11 Outdoor Education students may also be invited to join this trip.

## New Zealand or Tasmania

This annual trip provides students with leadership development opportunities and the chance to connect with their peers and experiences in nature. Students will participate in multi-day hikes along with shorter activities such as rock climbing and white water paddling.

Duration	Up to 2 weeks
Cost	\$2,300 per student

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# SPORT FACULTY

## Melbourne Netball Trip

This trip is open to female students in Year 8 to Year 12.

Timing	Week 9 or Week 10, Term 2 (in 2024, this trip will run from Monday 1 July to Friday 5 July)
Duration	5 days/4 nights
Cost	\$1,400 per student

Around 20 students and four staff will participate in this annual trip.

## Trinity Intercol Trip

This trip is for students in the Woodcroft College First XI Cricket team.

Timing	Week 1, Term 4
Duration	3 days/2 nights
Cost	\$250 per student

Around 12 students plus staff will participate in this biennial trip.

In 2024, Woodcroft College will host Trinity College.

## Australian Volleyball Schools Cup Gold Coast Trip

Students in Year 8 to Year 12 are invited to trial for selection for the female and male teams.

Timing	Week 9, Term 4
Duration	8 days/7 nights
Cost	\$2,400 per students

Between 20 to 40 students and 6 - 8 staff will participate in this annual trip.

## 2025 Inaugural Falls Creek Snow Trip

This trip will be open to students in Year 9 to Year 11 in 2025.

Timing	July holidays – final week
Duration	6 nights
Cost	\$2,000 per student

Up to 30 students plus staff will be able to participate in this trip.

## 2025 Brisbane Cricket Competition

This trip is open to male students in Year 8 to Year 12 in 2025.

Timing	January holidays (Sunday 5 January to Saturday 11 January)
Duration	7 days/6 nights
Cost	\$1,500 per student
