



HIGH PERFORMANCE ATHLETE SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND CRITERIA

Year 10 to Year 12 2026

Each year the College will award two scholarships to new or current students entering Year 10, Year 11 or Year 12 in the following year. Students must be competing at a State or National representation level to be eligible. Student written applications should be addressed to the HPAP Coordinator and include the following:

- Letter from student sharing a brief overview of their sporting journey and their aspirations for the future.
- Confirmation and evidence of representation in sport of choice at State or National level (must be current).
- Character reference from State or National Coach.
- Academic progress and achievement including copy of most recent school report.
- Supporting letter from parent.

Applicants will be shortlisted by the HPAP Coordinator and Head of Sport. Scholarships will be awarded on the recommendation of the HPAP Coordinator and the Head of Senior School. A short interview may be requested.

The scholarships will provide for the remission of 25 per cent of the annual student charges for one year and up to a maximum of two years* at Woodcroft College.

The decision to extend the Scholarship beyond one year, will be at the discretion of the HPAP Coordinator and Head of Senior School. Throughout the scholarship period, the student must demonstrate the College Values and meet expectations for Effort and Tutor Group Assessment attributes as noted on their Woodcroft College Reports.
