INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ENROLMENT PROCESS

1. Enrolment Application

An Education Agent will work with parents to complete an Enrolment Application for Overseas Students or parents can choose to complete this and send to the College directly. The Enrolment Application must be submitted with the following:

- School reports for the past two years
- Copy of Passport (current)
- English test results (if available)

*Woodcroft College recommends working with an Education Agent for support and advice throughout the enrolment process.

2. Review and Online Interview

The Woodcroft College International Program team will review student's reports and English test (if provided).

Based on satisfactory results, the student will be invited to an online interview (parents and/or agents are welcome to join students).

The interview is an informal discussion about the student's interests and reasons for wanting to come to Woodcroft College. It is about making sure that we are the right choice for the student and their family.

It is also an opportunity assess a student's English skills. If there are any concerns about the level of English, a student will be requested to sit a recognised English proficiency test.

3. Decision of Acceptance

Student Accepted

If accepted, a Letter of Offer, Enrolment Agreement and fee invoice will be sent to the Education Agent or the student's parents. Overseas Health Cover (OSHC) is a requirement of the student visa and will be included on the invoice. If families wish to purchase their own, they must supply a copy of the cover at the time of making payment.

Student Not Accepted

If a student is not accepted, the College will contact the Education Agent or the student's parents to inform them of the decision.

4. Acceptance of Offer

To accept the offer, the student's parents (or guardian) must sign and return the Letter of Offer and the Enrolment Agreement.

The required fees must be paid by the date indicated on the invoice.

5. Documentation Issued

Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) and Confirmation of Appropriate Accommodation and Welfare (CAAW) documents (if relevant) will be issued for the student to submit their visa application.

6. Arrival in Australia

The College will keep in close contact with the Education Agent and student on arrival details, airport pick up requirements and the Homestay allocation.

The Homestay family or Happy Homestay will meet the student at the airport. A photo will be sent to the Education Agent or parents to let the everyone know that the student has arrived safely.

The student will be welcomed to Woodcroft College with an orientation session, including introductions to staff and students. Along with arranging a uniform fitting, and all the necessary stationery, the International Program team will be on hand to help a student have a positive start to their studies at Woodcroft College.

Completion of the Enrolment Application will not necessarily guarantee enrolment at the College.

Entry Requirements

- 1. Students who want to study at Woodcroft College must have attained at least the equivalent level of study in their own country.
- 2. Students must submit their past two years of school reports for assessment by senior staff at the College. These must be translated into English if written in another language.
- 3. Students must have acceptable results in the subjects that they wish to study at Woodcroft College.
- 4. Full time students are generally required to undertake up to 20 weeks of English for Academic Purpose Course in order to prepare them for their mainstream course. The time required is dependent on their level of English on entry to the College.
- 5. Study Abroad students must have an appropriate English level to join mainstream classes without Englsh support.
- 6. Students will be required to participate in an online interview prior to acceptance and may need to complete a written English test.
- 7. The College's Student Services Policy requires parents to provide information relevant to any special needs that an applicant may have at the time of the Enrolment Application and/or before enrolment. Failure to disclose this information could result in the student's placement being delayed or withdrawn.

Special Note to Parents

- Enrolment at Woodcroft College is dependent on families accepting homestay accommodation as provided by Woodcroft College until the student leaves the College.
- The Head of Woodcroft College will be the legal guardian until the student turns 18 years of age.
- Student Responsibilities:
 - to meet Visa regulations.
 - to make satisfactory progress in his/her studies and to complete the course.
- Parent Responsibilities
 - to ensure adequate finances are available for the students living expenses and airfares.
- This Enrolment Application is the first step in the enrolment process and does not guarantee an offer of place. All offers are subject to an interview.
