



Seesaw is a digital student portfolio that gives students an authentic audience for their work. It gives families a window into what's going on every day in their child's classroom.

It is also a great place where teachers can share class news and student progress with you.

Students

Students add posts to their journals. Student posts showcase the creative projects they have been working on in the classroom. This could include photos, artwork, videos, activities, notes, projects they have created in other apps, and more.

Families

Families get notified when there are new posts in their student's journal. They can view posts and add likes and comments.

Seesaw requires an invite from your child's teacher in order to sign up. This invite will be sent home in the first few weeks of school. Up to 10 family members can connect to one child's journal.

Adding your child

Once you receive your invitation simply follow the instructions on how to add your child.
