Service Location

Woodcroft College Vacation Care operates from the Woodcroft College OSHC Building which is located opposite the Junior School Building.

Operating Hours

The Vacation Care Program operates from 6.45am to 6.15pm during the school holidays & Pupil Free Days.

Arrival & Departure

All children must be signed in and signed out by their parent/guardian. All parents will receive a code to sign their children in/out via the OSHC iPad. The OSHC iPad is located inside the OSHC room door.

Parents/caregivers must accompany their child/ren to and from the service. Children will not be allowed to meet parents outside the facility. This procedure is to ensure the safety of your child and to meet government safety requirements.

Enrolment

All children attending the Vacation Care Program must be enrolled with Woodcroft College OSHC. Enrolment Forms can be located on the College website, or a hard copy can be collected from the Junior School OSHC.

Vacation Care Bookings

Parents will be notified when the program and booking form is available via School Stream.

Download and complete the online booking form. Save as a PDF and return as an attachment to woodcroftoshc@woodcroft.sa.edu.au.

Tash or Sally will confirm your booking request form and confirm availability within a week of bookings open date.

Consent for Excursions

The College uses Consent2Go as an alternative to paper records and consent forms. Consent2Go will inform you about any excursions that are planned as part of our Vacation Care Program. If your child is booked into our program on a day that an excursion is planned an email will be sent asking you to complete consent for your child to attend. Consent2Go is also the collection point for student health information. Prior to giving consent you will be prompted to check and update where necessary, any medical or health information for your child.

Daily Fee

Vacation Care OSHC Based: \$75 per child, per day
Vacation Care Excursion: \$90 per child, per day

Fee Payment

To attend Vacation Care please fill in a Direct Debit Authority form and return with your enrolment. Invoices will be sent weekly by email.

Cancellations

Once we have received your booking form, full fees will be charged for any cancellations, unless we are able to fill your child's spot from our waitlist.

What to Bring

Recess, lunch, afternoon tea and a water bottle must be brought each day.

If children are staying for a long day, we do suggest you pack extra snacks.

We follow the Woodcroft College Nut Free Policy. No food containing nuts is to be brought to Vacation Care.

Sun Smart Policy

A copy of the sun safe policy is available upon request.

Slip: Please pick lightweight loose clothing during vacation care period. Clothing needs to cover most of your child's body including arms and legs. No thongs are to be worn during Vacation Care.

Slop: It is recommended that sunscreen be liberally applied to all areas of skin that is difficult to cover with clothing.

Slap: It is policy that every child must be wearing a Woodcroft College hat during Vacation Care.

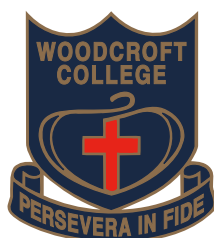
Friday 18 July
