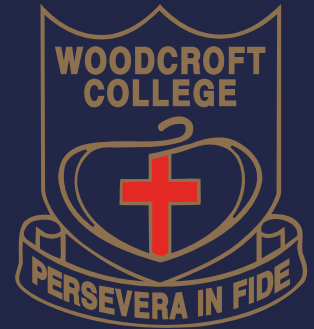

KEEP GROWING

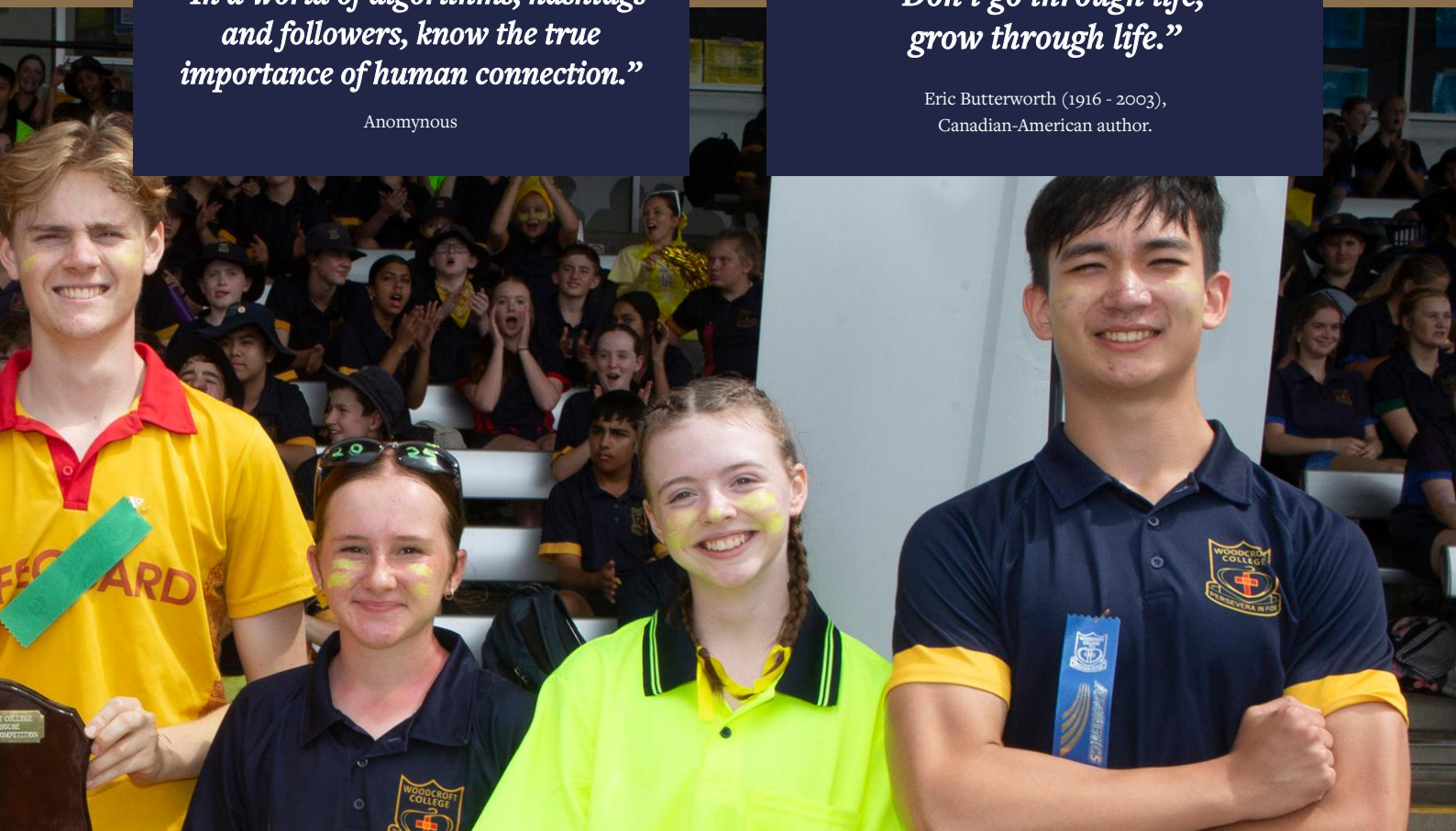
